Concession Stand Guidelines

Preface: Without the revenue generated from concessions, the band participation fees would be well over \$500 per member. Volunteers are a vital part in the success of the Band programs in the Valdosta City School System. EVERY band student benefits from the hard work of our Concession Volunteers. “Thanks” is never enough for the impact you make on the lives of our children.

1. Volunteers must have a Concession Volunteer Form on file with the Concession Chairperson prior to volunteering at any concession activity.
2. Volunteers must be approved by the Valdosta Band Booster’s Executive Board.
3. Volunteers will be utilized on a rotation method based on availability data on the volunteer forms. Availability does not guarantee a position.
4. Volunteers will be assigned to a duty area. Notification of this will be done via phone or email. No volunteer will be utilized if they are not on the duty roster for that night’s game.
5. Volunteers are requested to phone the Concessions Chairperson by Thursday night prior to a game if they are unable to fulfill their responsibility.
6. Volunteers are expected to arrive at their assigned duty area on or before the following times:
 - a. Grill Team: 4:30 pm
 - b. Wrap Team: 4:45 pm
 - c. Concession Managers: 5:30 pm
 - d. All Volunteers: 5:45 pm
7. Volunteers may enjoy their choice of these complimentary items by recording such on the “Munchies for Concession Volunteers” form located at each Concession stand:
 - a. 1 hamburger or 1 hotdog or 1 pizza slice with
 - b. 1 nacho or 1 popcorn and
 - c. 1 drinkAdditional items may be purchased at the stadium price.
8. Eating will be done during breaks. No one should eat while serving food or at the service windows while there are patrons waiting to be served.
9. All concession volunteers are expected to wash their hands thoroughly prior to and during their time of service.
10. Persons with a cold/flu, or those with cuts or sores on their hands will be asked to volunteer after these issues have passed.
11. All foods shall be prepared and/or cooked on site at the concession stands.
12. Foods shall not be touched by bare hands. Gloves, tongs, spatulas, deli tissue, aluminum foil, or other utensils are to be used. This includes Wrap Team, Passers, and those who prepare Nachos and Popcorn.
13. Smoking is prohibited in all Concession areas.
14. Volunteers will sign out at the end of the evening with their Concessions Manager. Upon completion of the full night, \$10.00 will be credited to the student account indicated by the volunteer.
15. Exceptions to any of the above must be agreed upon by the Concessions Chairperson and Concessions Manager of whose concession stand is directly affected by the change and is valid for that game only.
